FUNDING TO MANITOBA, 2000-2001

- In 2000-2001, the Canada Council for the Arts provided grants worth \$5.9 million to the arts in Manitoba.
- In addition, almost \$190,000 in payments was provided to 367 Manitoba authors through the Public Lending Right Program¹. This brings the total amount of Canada Council funding to Manitoba to just over \$6.1 million.
- The Council awarded \$606,645 in grants to 67 Manitoba artists and \$5.3 million to 73 Manitoba arts organizations.
- Grants were provided in every artistic discipline – dance, music, theatre, visual arts, media arts, writing and publishing and interdisciplinary art. The largest amount of funding (\$1.4 million) went to dance, followed by music (\$1.4 million) and theatre (\$921,787).
- \$5.7 million in Council funding went to artists and arts organizations in Winnipeg, making up 96% of the funding going to the province. In total, six other communities in Manitoba received \$226,345 (about 4% of the total).
- 26 artists and arts professionals from Manitoba served as peer assessors in 2000-2001, making up 4.3% of all peer assessors.
- Manitoba artists and arts organizations received 5.65% of Canada Council funding. In comparison, the province makes up approximately 3.3% of cultural workers and 3.7% of the population of Canada.
- According to the 1996 Census, there are 15,700 culture workers in Manitoba including 3,770 artists.

AIDE ACCORDÉE AU MANITOBA, 2000-2001

- En 2000-2001, le Conseil des Arts du Canada a accordé des subventions d'une valeur totale de 5,9 millions de dollars au secteur des arts du Manitoba.
- De plus, près de 190 000 \$ ont été versés, sous forme de paiements, à 367 auteurs manitobains, par l'entremise du Programme du droit de prêt public, ce qui porte le total des fonds versés par le Conseil des Arts du Canada au Manitoba à un peu plus de 6,1 millions de dollars.
- Le Conseil a attribué 606 645 \$ en subventions à 67 artistes du Manitoba, ainsi que 5,3 millions de dollars à 73 organismes artistiques de cette province.
- Des subventions ont été accordées dans toutes les disciplines artistiques : la danse, la musique, le théâtre, les arts visuels, les arts médiatiques, les lettres et édition, et l'interdisciplinarité. La plus importante tranche de financement (1,4 million de dollars) a été attribuée à la danse. Viennent ensuite la musique (1,4 million de dollars) et le théâtre (921 787 \$).
- Les artistes et les organismes artistiques de Winnipeg ont reçu 5,7 millions de dollars, soit 96 p. 100 du montant que le Conseil des Arts a versé au Manitoba. Au total, six autres collectivités manitobaines ont reçu 226 345 \$ (soit environ 4 p. 100 du total versé).
- Au total, 26 artistes et spécialistes du domaine des arts du Manitoba ont fait partie de comités d'évaluation par les pairs en 2000-2001, représentant 4,3 p. 100 de l'ensemble des pairs évaluateurs.
- Les artistes et les organismes artistiques du Manitoba ont reçu 5,65 p. 100 des sommes accordées par le Conseil des Arts du Canada. À titre comparatif, le Manitoba compte environ 3,3 p. 100 des travailleurs du secteur culturel au pays et 3,7 p. 100 de la population du Canada.
- D'après le Recensement de 1996, le Manitoba compte 15 700 travailleurs dans le secteur culturel, y compris 3770 artistes.

MANITOBA ARTS ORGANIZATIONS FUNDED BY THE CANADA COUNCIL, 2000-2001

The Winnipeg based film co-operative **Video Pool** received several grants from the Canada Council in 2000-2001. Grants to Video Pool totalled \$209,500, awarded from various grant programs including Media Arts Development Project Grants, Annual Assistance for Programming Grants and Dissemination Project Grants. The Dissemination Project Grant will contribute to a travelling series of six programs entitled "Magnetic North." The tour began in November 2000 and is running through to October 2002 in North America and abroad. The programs are made up of short films grouped by a specific theme such as "Seen on the Body" and "Making Strange, Making Familiar". The six programs include the works of 47 individual artists in English, French and Aboriginal languages.

The **St. Norbert Arts Centre** was the only Inter-Arts grant recipient from Manitoba in 2000-2001, receiving a \$20,000 creation grant. Winnipeg's St. Norbert Arts Centre is Manitoba's only residency-based, non-disciplinary arts organization dedicated to contemporary art and expanding audiences. The project for which they sought funding was a weeklong residency led by artists Faith Wilding and Bev Pike that focused on feminist activism in the health care profession. During the residency six participants were involved in the design of an exhibition, a direct intervention educational campaign and a daylong public forum. With the guidance of the resident artists the groups undertook an examination of cultural influence on sexual practices and gender construction through the discussion of emerging technologies of fertility, reproduction, and genetic and medical engineering.

The renowned **Royal Winnipeg Ballet (RWB)** received a total of \$1,165,000 in grants from the Canada Council for the Arts in 2000-2001. Grants were given for Creation and Production in Dance and for Dance Touring Grants. A portion of the grant money went towards the season's touring which took the company to Saskatchewan. The RWB is the only company to undertake annual visits to Central Canada as part of its national touring activities. Lower ticket revenues in this area have deterred other companies, however, the RWB has played to sold out houses in Saskatchewan in the past.

AIDE ACCORDÉE PAR LE CONSEIL DES ARTS DU CANADA AUX ORGANISMES ARTISTIQUES MANITOBAINS EN 2000-2001

Située à Winnipeg, la coopérative cinématographique **Video Pool** a reçu plusieurs subventions du Conseil des Arts du Canada pendant l'exercice de 2000-2001. Au total, Video Pool a obtenu 209 500 \$ de différents programmes de subventions, incluant les Subventions d'aide aux projets de développement en arts médiatiques, l'Aide annuelle à la programmation, et les Subventions d'aide annuelle aux projets de diffusion. L'aide annuelle aux projets de diffusion servira à financer en partie une série itinérante de six programmes intitulée *Magnetic North*. La tournée en Amérique du Nord et dans d'autres pays a commencé en novembre 2000 et prendra fin en octobre 2002. Les programmes sont composés de courts métrages regroupés selon des thèmes précis, tels *Seen on the Body* et *Making Strange, Making Familiar*. Les six programmes comprennent des œuvres de 47 artistes en anglais, en français et dans différentes langues autochtones.

La **Maison d'art et de la culture de Saint-Norbert** a été le seul récipiendaire manitobain d'une subvention de la discipline Inter-arts en 2000-2001; l'organisme a reçu une subvention de création d'une valeur de 20 000 \$. La Maison d'art et de la culture de Saint-Norbert, qui est le seul organisme artistique au Manitoba non associé à une discipline particulière, est basée sur des programmes de résidence. Le Centre se consacre à l'art contemporain et à l'accroissement des publics. La Maison a sollicité des fonds pour son projet de résidence d'une semaine, projet dirigé par les artistes Faith Wilding et Bev Pike et qui est axée sur le militantisme féministe dans la profession des soins de santé. Pendant la semaine en résidence, six participantes ont collaboré à la conception d'une exposition, d'une campagne d'éducation basée sur le modèle de l'intervention directe, et d'une tribune publique d'une journée. Encadrées par les artistes en résidence, les membres des groupes ont examiné l'influence de la culture sur les pratiques sexuelles et sur l'identité sexuelle, au moyen d'une discussion des technologies nouvelles de fertilité de procréation, et de génie génétique et médical.

Le célèbre **Royal Winnipeg Ballet** a reçu des subventions totalisant 1 165 000 \$ du Conseil des Arts du Canada pendant l'exercice de 2000-2001. Les sommes ont été attribuées en application des programmes de Création/production en danse et d'Aide à la tournée en danse. Une partie des subventions a servi à financer la tournée saisonnière de la compagnie en Saskatchewan. Cette compagnie est la seule à organiser des tournées annuelles dans la région du centre du Canada, dans le cadre de ses activités nationales de tournée. Bon nombre d'autres compagnies ont renoncé aux tournées dans cette région en raison de la faiblesse des ventes de billets. Par contre, le Royal Winnipeg Ballet a déjà présenté des spectacles à guichets fermés en Saskatchewan.
