FUNDING TO SASKATCHEWAN, 2000-2001

- In 2000-2001, the Canada Council for the Arts provided grants worth almost \$2.8 million to the arts in Saskatchewan.
- In addition, \$165,500 in payments was provided to 272 Saskatchewan authors through the Public Lending Right Program¹. This brings the total amount of Canada Council funding to Saskatchewan to almost \$3.0 million.
- The Council awarded \$301,123 in grants to 48 Saskatchewan artists and \$2.5 million to 60 Saskatchewan arts organizations.
- Grants were provided in every artistic discipline - dance, music, theatre, visual arts, media arts, writing and publishing and interdisciplinary art. The largest amount of funding (\$790,000) went to visual arts, followed by theatre (\$533,083) and writing and publishing (\$525,776).
- Over \$1.3 million in Council funding went to artists and arts organizations in Regina, making up (49%) of the funding going to the province. Saskatoon received over \$1.2 million (about 45% of the total). In total, all other communities in Saskatchewan received \$182,423 (almost 6% of the total).
- Saskatchewan artists and arts organizations received 2.66% of Canada Council funding in 2000-2001. In comparison, the province makes up approximately 2.3% of cultural workers and 3.4% of the population of Canada.
- According to the 1996 Census, there are over 11,000 culture workers in Saskatchewan, including over 3,100 artists.

AIDE ACCORDÉE À LA SASKATCHEWAN, 2000-2001

- En 2000-2001 le Conseil des Arts du Canada a accordé des subventions d'une valeur totale de près de 2,8 millions de dollars aux arts de la Saskatchewan.
- Par ailleurs, il a fait des paiements d'une valeur totale de 165 500 \$ à 272 auteurs de la Saskatchewan dans le cadre du Programme du droit de prêt public.² Ces paiements portent à près de 3,0 millions de dollars le montant total des fonds que la Saskatchewan a reçus du Conseil des Arts du Canada.
- Le Conseil a accordé des subventions d'une valeur totale de 301, 123 \$ à 48 artistes de la Saskatchewan et de 2,5 millions de dollars à 60 organismes artistiques de la Saskatchewan.
- Le Conseil a attribué des subventions dans toutes les disciplines artistiques- danse, musique, théâtre, arts visuels, arts médiatiques, lettres et édition et art interdisciplinaire. Le montant le plus élevé (790,000 \$) a été attribué aux arts visuels, suivis par le théâtre (533, 083 \$) et lettres et édition (525, 776 \$).
- Le Conseil a accordé plus de 1,3 million aux artistes et organismes artistiques de Regina, soit 49 % des fonds accordés à la province. La ville de Saskatoon a reçu plus de 1,2 million de dollars (environ 45 % du total). En tout, toutes les autres collectivités de la Saskatchewan ont reçu 182, 423 \$ (près de 6 % du total).
- Les artistes et organismes artistiques de la Saskatchewan ont reçu 2,66 % de l'aide du Conseil des Arts du Canada. La province représente approximativement 2,3 % des travailleurs du secteur culturel et 3,4 % de la population du Canada.
- Selon le recensement de 1996, la Saskatchewan compte 11 000 travailleurs du secteur culturel, dont 3 100 artistes.

SASKATCHEWAN ORGANIZATIONS THAT RECEIVED CANADA COUNCIL FUNDING, 2000-2001

Saskatchewan Native Theatre Company Inc. (SNTC) received a number of grants for a total of \$36,400 in 2000-2001 from the Canada Council. Playwright Kenneth Charlette's play, *Neyo-Miyo-Uk*, was presented at the Saskatoon Fringe 2000 to rave reviews and has been scheduled by the Saskatchewan Native Theatre Company for further script development. The play strengthens and builds on the positive image of Aboriginal cultures and performing artists in Saskatchewan. Plans now include turning the piece into a full production and touring it abroad. SNTC has proposed a Centre for the Study of Script Development, possibly with the collaboration of the University of Regina who have expressed interest in a project to assist playwrights such as Charlette.

The **Regina International Children's Festival** received a \$350 grant through the Canada Council's Outreach Program in 2000-2001. The Festival exists "to open young minds to the arts by providing children with original theatre and artistic experiences". The grant enabled the Festival's artistic director, Christa Donaldson, to travel to the premiere of "The Boy in the Tree house" at the Manitoba Theatre for Young People. This play by Drew Hayden tackles the familiar Canadian situation of growing up with parents of different cultures. The play is now going to be considered for the next Children's Festival and it is believed that the production would be well received by Saskatchewan's young audiences.

ORGANISMES DE LA SASKATCHEWAN QUI ONT REÇU DE L'AIDE DU CONSEIL DES ARTS EN 2000-2001

En 2000-2001, la **Saskatchewan Native Theatre Company Inc. (SNTC)** a reçu au total 36 400 \$ en subventions du Conseil des Arts du Canada. La pièce du dramaturge Kenneth Charlette, *Neyo-Miyo-Uk*, présentée à la Saskatoon Fringe 2000 a fait l'objet de critiques dithyrambiques et le SNTC prévoit travailler davantage son manuscrit. La pièce renforce et étoffe l'image positive des cultures et des artistes autochtones de la scène en Saskatchewan. On compte maintenant faire de cette pièce une production globale et la présenter en tournée à l'étranger. Le SNTC a proposé d'établir un centre d'étude et d'élaboration de scénarios, possiblement en collaboration avec l'Université de Regina qui a manifesté son intérêt à participer à un projet d'aide aux dramaturges tels Charlette.

En 2000-2001, le **Regina International Children's Festival** a reçu une subvention de 350 \$ dans le cadre du Programme de promotion de la diffusion du Conseil des Arts du Canada. Le festival a été créé afin de « sensibiliser les jeunes esprits aux arts en offrant aux enfants des expériences artistiques et théâtrales originales ». La subvention a permis à Christa Donaldson, directrice artistique du Festival, d'assister à la première de la pièce *The Boy in the Tree House* au Manitoba Theatre for Young People. Cette pièce de Drew Hayden traite d'une situation familiale à de nombreux Canadiens : être élevé par des parents de cultures différentes. La pièce est maintenant à l'étude en vue d'être présentée au prochain Children's Festival et il semble que la production sera bien reçue par les jeunes publics de la Saskatchewan.
