1.0 Overview of Canada Council funding to British Columbia in 2006-07

- In 2006-07, the Canada Council for the Arts provided grants totalling \$19.7 million to artists and arts organizations in British Columbia.
- In addition to grants, \$1.2 million in payments was provided to 2,237 authors through the Public Lending Right Program in 2006-07.¹ This brings total Canada Council funding to British Columbia to \$20.9 million.
- The Council awarded \$3.2 million (16%) in grants to 302 artists and \$16.5 million (84%) to 336 British Columbia arts organizations in 2006-07.
- Grants were awarded to artists and arts organizations in British Columbia in all disciplines - dance, interdisciplinary and performance art, music, media arts, theatre, visual arts and writing and publishing. In 2006-07, the largest amount of funding went to music (\$4.1 million). Visual arts received the second largest amount of funding (\$3.0 million) followed by both writing and publishing and theatre (\$2.8 million).
- 2,397 applications from British Columbia artists and arts organizations were submitted to the Council in 2006-07, representing 15.3% of the total number of applications received.
- Funding to artists and arts organizations in Vancouver totaled \$14.3 million, comprising 72.8% of the total funding going to British Columbia. In Victoria, they received \$1.9 million in funds, representing 9.8% of total funding. A total of 72 additional communities in British Columbia received \$3.4 million, or 17.4% of all funding to the province in 2006-07.
- In 2006-07, British Columbia artists received 15.2% of Canada Council funding to artists, and British Columbia arts organizations received 13.8% of the funding to arts organizations. In total, British Columbia artists and arts organizations received 14.0% of Canada Council funding. In comparison, British Columbia makes up 18.4% of Canadian artists,² and represents 13.0% of the total population of Canada.³
- As a result of the increase to the Canada Council's parliamentary appropriation (for the fiscal years 2006-07 and 2007-08) announced in the federal budget of May 2006, 78 arts organizations in British Columbia received \$4.5 million over a two year period as part of the Supplementary Operating Funds Initiative.
- 111 British Columbia artists and arts professionals served as peer assessors in 2006-07, making up 14.3% of all peer assessors.

2.0 Statistical highlights about the arts in British Columbia⁴

- With 24,100 artists, British Columbia is the province with the largest percentage of its labour force in arts occupations (1.1%). Artists represent 0.8% of the overall labour force in Canada.
- Among large Canadian cities, Vancouver has the highest concentration of artists in the local labour force. Three of the four cities with the highest artistic concentrations are in British Columbia – Vancouver, Victoria and North Vancouver District Municipality. Of the nine large cities with artistic concentrations above 1.0%, five are in British Columbia:
 - Vancouver ranks first among large cities with an artistic concentration of 2.4%;
 - Victoria has the second-highest concentration of artists (2.0%);
 - North Vancouver (District Municipality) has the fourth-highest artistic concentration among large cities (1.8%);
 - Saanich ranks eighth (1.2%);
 - New Westminster is ninth (1.1%);
- 30% of B.C.'s artists reside in Vancouver (7,250), compared with 14% of the province's overall labour force.
- British Columbians spent "\$3.6 billion on cultural goods and services in 2005 or 3.2% of total consumer spending in the province. The \$3.6 billion in consumer spending on culture is more than four times larger than the \$780 million spent on culture in British Columbia by all levels of government in 2003/04. On a per capita basis, British Columbians' cultural spending is the second highest of all provinces at \$886 per resident."⁵

Examples of Canada Council funding in British Columbia⁶

The Canada Council supports the endeavours of professional artists and arts organizations through its programs. The following selection illustrates the scope of the activities supported by the Canada Council in British Columbia.

Julie Lebel of Vancouver received **\$5,000** from the **Grants to Dance Professionals** and the **Artists and the Community Collaboration Program** to produce the work entitled ***Terrain d'action: la sensation physique d'être à quelque part (Field of Action: the Physical Sensation of Being Somewhere)***, from March, 2006 to September, 2007. **Lebel's** project explores the relationship between dance, music and public spaces through the Mobile Clubbing (MC) interface. In MC, a small group of people meet together in a public place, put on earphones and over the course of a set period of time dance to music playing on a personal stereo. The public forays are documented through sound recordings, photos, video, drawings and maps.

The **Assistance to Visual Artists - Project Grants** program awarded Vancouver artist **Sonny Assu** a **\$20,000** grant to create a series of pop/consumer culture inspired First Nations artwork in 2006-07. The works **Assu** will create include painted drums made of deer hide, the ***Potlatch-a-pollooza series*** and the ***Breakfast series v2/Lunch Series***. **Assu** wrote that his current artistic practice: "examines how we use everyday consumer items and icons of pop culture to define our personal lineage. My work has developed into a wry social commentary that not only pokes fun at perceived stereotypes but helps educate people on the issues at hand in the First Nations community."

Pitt Meadows' music/spoken word trio **The Fugitives** received its first grant of **\$12,700** from the **Spoken Word and Storytelling Program** to create a collaborative spoken word piece entitled ***Face of Impurity*** from October 2006 to May 2007. **The Fugitives** not only created the work but also toured and performed the piece at secondary schools and recorded it on CD. In ***Face of Impurity*** the group raises issues relevant to youth including finding balance, accepting yourself, coming of age and overcoming obstacles, in the hopes of inspiring youth to "approach language with more enthusiasm, and propel them to celebrate, think, and care about the world through writing of their own."

The **Art Gallery of Greater Victoria** acquired two works with a grant of **\$9,500** awarded by the **Acquisition Assistance for Art Museums and Public Galleries** program in 2006-07. *Memorial Work for Hayusdisalas* (2004) by **Marianne Nicolson**, a Kwakwaka'waka artist from Comox, and **Untitled** diptych (1997) by **Vincent Trasov** of Edmonton are now in the Art Gallery's collection. The acquisition of works by these distinguished artists reflects the Art Gallery's mandate of "supporting and conserving for future generations, nationally significant regional art practice through our collections." Both works are scheduled to be shown in the Art Gallery's exhibition of recent acquisitions in 2007.

West Vancouver's **L'hen Awtwx Weaving Collective** received a **\$13,900** grant from the **Aboriginal Peoples Collaborative Exchange: National** program to teach Coast Salish weaving to Sliammon First Nation students in Powell River from September to October 2006. Workshops were facilitated by **Janice George** and **Willard (Buddy) Joseph**, who provided looms, wool and other tools required to complete the creation of shawls, blankets and tunics. The facilitators wrote: "by focusing on this art form it is anticipated that a revived interest in the protection and enhancement of Coast Salish weaving will result in Coast Salish weaving being worn for ceremonial purposes, display and a promotion of the Coast Salish culture."

Anthropologist and author **Guy Pierre Buchholtzer** of Vancouver received a **\$10,000** grant from the **Grants to Professional Writers - Creative Writing** program. **Buchholtzer** will research and write about the Surrealist movement and 20th century ideas concerning the artistic and socio-cultural world of North American Aboriginal peoples with a specific focus on British Columbia and Alaska. He expects to publish several short articles, complete research, analyse archival material and compile a 160 to 185 page manuscript. Originally from France, **Buchholtzer** now lives in BC, where he has worked with First Nations people for several decades.

In 2006-07 **Janice Wong** of Vancouver received a **\$20,000** grant from the **Assistance to Visual Artists - Project Grants** program to adapt traditional textile construction and printmaking techniques for large works on paper. These works will explore concepts of transition, centering on the loss of language and include elements from a Chinese Taoist document, a diagram of change. **Wong** wrote: "I am interested in conveying metaphors for ways in which loss of language, which optimally functions as a tool for communication and understanding, can divide cultures and generations, how language and cultures evolve and how language can be lost, altered, obscured or secreted."

Vancouver's **Pangaea Arts Society** was awarded a **\$10,000** grant by the **Theatre Production Project Grants: Established Artists' Development/Production** program to produce **The Gull: The Stevenson Noh Project**, in 2006-07. **The Gull** is an original Canadian Noh theatre play (an integrated combination of dance, chant, music, ritual and dance) written by Daphne Marlatt about the experience of Japanese Canadian fishermen returning to Richmond (Stevenson) following their release from the internment camps of WWII. Traditional Japanese Noh Theatre masters collaborated with Canadian theatre artists for the performance at the Richmond Cultural Centre and a Noh workshop at Richmond Secondary School.

Daphne Odjig of Penticton was a recipient of a **\$25,000 Governor General's Awards in Visual and Media Arts** in 2007. **Odjig** is an artist and cultural worker of Pottawatomi, Odawa and English backgrounds, whose name and images are known worldwide. The Executive Director of Kamloops Art Gallery, Jann L.M. Bailey nominated **Odjig** to “recognise the remarkable achievements of an even more remarkable woman, who paved the way for so many Aboriginal artists in a time when female artists – let alone female Aboriginal artists – had so often to fight their way into acceptance within the contemporary visual art scene.”

In 2006-07 the **Prince George Symphony Orchestra Society (PGSO)** received a **\$20,000** grant from the **Music - Supplementary Operating Funds Initiative** to tour Simon Coles’s piece entitled **A Northern Quest** through northern British Columbia. **A Northern Quest** was written for a mezzo soprano and chamber orchestra and includes themes of the grandeur and balance of nature, the interconnectedness of all things including all peoples, and the need to look inside for enlightenment. Internationally successful soprano Marion Newman of Bella Coola will most likely perform the piece. **PGSO** seeks to connect with youth by providing an entertaining experience and creating an on-going interactive web site.

The **Inter-Arts Program: Travel Grants to Professional Artists** awarded **Ruby Rowat** of Vancouver a **\$2,500** grant to present interdisciplinary circus arts at the Tasmania Circus Festival from February 3 to 12, 2007, in Australia. **Rowat** wrote “Just as I think it crucially beneficial for local Canadian artists to be exposed to Circus Oz’s (or other Australian circus, such as circus Monoxide or Acrobat) interpretation of contemporary circus, I am aware that there are elements of the creative process that are unique to me and Canada.” While at the festival **Rowat** attended master classes and worked with other collaborative artists to strengthen her “spy/cat burglar” character and creative use of space.

Vancouver’s **Ronsdale Press** was awarded a **\$15,000** grant by the **Book Publishing Support - Grants for Art Books** program to compile and publish **Utopic Impulses: Essays in Contemporary Ceramics** in 2006-07. **Utopic Impulses** will be an “edited anthology engaging the diverse field of contemporary ceramics practise. Primarily Canadian in scope, the anthology includes nine critical essays by new and established writers, which investigate ceramics and social activism, craft and ceramics histories and contemporary craft and ceramic theory.” The anthology will be edited by **Ruth Chambers, Amy Gogarty** and **Mireille Peron** and will contain 70 colour and 20 black and white illustrations.

The **Grants to Theatre Artists** program awarded **Nicholas Hutchinson** of Dunster a **\$15,000** grant to write the first draft of a new play entitled **A Mingled Yarn**. **Hutchinson** will write the play based on raw material which traces his grandparents’ “connection to what developed from the seeds sown by the [Gordon] Craig/ [Constantin] Stanislavsky collaboration in European and North American theatre from 1907 to 1946.” Using correspondence between his grandmother and Craig as well as research from a trip to Moscow and the archives at Texas University, **Hutchinson** will create a work that explores “the re-invention of the theatre and rediscovery of its art and potency.”

The **Equity Office's Intersectional Initiatives** awarded Vancouver independent curator **Niranjan Rajah** a grant of **\$20,000** to produce an exhibition in 2007 based on research conducted during a residency at Surrey Art Gallery from June, 2005 to May, 2006. During the residency, **Rajah** researched how media technologies have affected the expression of the sacred in terms of space in contemporary art, architecture and human computer interaction, taking into consideration diverse cultural practises. The exhibition "will include an examination of the use of traditional materials and methods as well as analog and digital technologies for worship, contemplation and popular consumption of mythical narrative and spiritual practices."

The **Annual Assistance to Media Arts Festivals** program awarded Victoria's **Runnymede Enhancement Society** a **\$25,000** grant to produce the **Antimatter Underground Film Festival** from September 21 to 29, 2007. The festival exists to "provide a public platform for underground productions of film and video - imaginative, volatile, entertaining and critical works that exist outside the mainstream. It is a forum for innovative and radical ideas overlooked or marginalized by contemporary culture." For its 10th anniversary the festival will host several special events including a screening program featuring ten Canadian filmmakers who previously participated in the festival.

Vancouver's **Boca Del Lupo Theatre** was selected as the 2006 winner of the **\$10,000 Theatre for Young Audience Prize** for their production of **Vasily the Luckless**. Based on Russian folktales, **Vasily the Luckless** is the story of an "orphan who always seems to end up in the unluckiest of situations. When a prophecy is made claiming that he will one day inherit the fortune of Marco the Rich, the wealthiest man in the land, Vasily must use all his wits, and the help of a few friends, to foil Marco's cunning plans." **Boca Del Lupo Theatre** performed **Vasily the Luckless** as part of its free, outdoor, all-ages, roving productions set in Stanley Park.

4.0 Overall arts and culture funding in British Columbia from all three levels of government⁷

- Arts and culture funding to British Columbia from all three levels of government stood at \$777.3 million in 2003-04 (the latest year of overall data from Statistics Canada).
- Municipal funding made up the largest share at 40% (\$309.5 million) with another 34% (\$264.7 million) coming from provincial sources. Federal funding (\$203.1 million) made up the smallest share of total government expenditures to British Columbia at 26% of total government expenditures on culture.
- Federal government cultural funding to British Columbia totalling \$203.1 million is primarily concentrated (83%) in three areas – heritage resources (historic parks/sites and nature/provincial parks), broadcasting and film and video. The remaining 17% of funding (\$35 million) is allocated to areas including performing arts (\$14.7 million), literary arts (\$8.1 million), multidisciplinary arts (\$6.8 million) and visual arts and crafts (\$3.4 million). In the comparable year, (2003-04), Canada Council funding accounted for 9% of all federal cultural spending in British Columbia.
- Between 1999-00 and 2003-04, federal cultural spending in British Columbia increased from \$144 million to \$203.1 million (an increase of 41%). During the same period, Canada Council funding in British Columbia increased from \$14.5 million to \$18.5 million.
- The largest part of provincial government funding (87%) is concentrated in three areas – libraries, heritage resources and multidisciplinary. However, funding is also allocated to arts education (\$11.0 million), broadcasting (\$7.8 million) and film and video (\$7.0 million).

5.0 Detailed tables of Canada Council funding to British Columbia

Canada Council for the Arts funding to British Columbia

- Since 1999-00, Canada Council funding to British Columbia significantly increased, rising from \$14.5 million in 1999-00 to \$19.7 million in 2006-07 (an increase of 36.31%).
- Grants to British Columbia as a percentage of total Canada Council funding remained relatively unchanged from 14.03% in 1999-00 to 13.98% in 2006-07.

Grant applications from British Columbia

- Since 1999-00, the total number of grant applications from British Columbia artists and arts organizations has decreased substantially from 2,643 applications in 1999-00 to 2,397 applications in 2006-07. British Columbia's share of grant applications decreased from 17.69% in 1999-00 to 15.30% in 2006-07. Its share of grant applications (15.30%) in 2006-07 is above its share of population (13.01%) but lower than its share of artists (18.4%) – see Table 7.

British Columbia – Various comparisons with other provinces⁸

- In terms of level of Canada Council funding, British Columbia is in third place at 13.98%. The province's share of funding is slightly higher than its share of population but lower than its share of applications and its share of artists. British Columbia ranks sixth in terms of Canada Council funding on a per capita basis per province at \$4.79.
