1.0 Overview of Canada Council funding to British Columbia in 2007-08

- In 2007-08, the Canada Council for the Arts provided grants totalling \$22.6 million to artists and arts organizations in British Columbia.
- In addition to grants, \$1.2 million in payments was provided to 2,446 authors through the Public Lending Right program,¹ as well as \$479,500 in special funds in 2007-08. This brings total Canada Council funding to British Columbia to \$24.2 million.
- The Council awarded \$3.6 million (16%) in grants to 343 artists and \$18.9 million (84%) to 362 British Columbia arts organizations in 2007-08.
- Grants were awarded to artists and arts organizations in British Columbia in all disciplines - dance, interdisciplinary and performance art, music, media arts, theatre, visual arts and writing and publishing. In 2007-08, the largest amount of funding went to music (\$6.0 million). Visual arts received the second largest amount of funding (\$3.6 million) followed by writing and publishing (\$3.2 million).
- 2,365 applications from British Columbia artists and arts organizations were submitted to the Council in 2007-08, representing 16% of the total number of applications received.
- Funding to artists and arts organizations in Vancouver totalled \$16.2 million, comprising 71.7% of the total funding going to British Columbia. In Victoria, they received \$2.3 million in funds, representing 10.2% of total funding, while Kamloops received \$404,889. A total of 84 additional communities in British Columbia received \$3.7 million, or 16.3% of all funding to the province in 2007-08.
- In 2007-08, British Columbia artists received 15.6% of Canada Council funding to artists, and British Columbia arts organizations received 14.6% of the funding to arts organizations. In total, British Columbia artists and arts organizations received 14.8% of Canada Council funding. In comparison, British Columbia makes up 18.4% of Canadian artists,² and represents 13.3% of the total population of Canada.³
- 116 British Columbia artists and arts professionals served as peer assessors in 2007-08, making up 15% of all peer assessors.

2.0 Statistical highlights about the arts in British Columbia⁴

- With 24,100 artists, British Columbia is the province with the largest percentage of its labour force in arts occupations (1.1%). Artists represent 0.8% of the overall labour force in Canada.
- Among large Canadian cities, Vancouver has the highest concentration of artists in the local labour force. Three of the four cities with the highest artistic concentrations are in British Columbia: Vancouver, Victoria and North Vancouver District Municipality. Of the nine large cities with artistic concentrations above 1.0%, five are in British Columbia:
 - Vancouver ranks first among large cities with an artistic concentration of 2.4%;
 - Victoria has the second-highest concentration of artists (2.0%);
 - North Vancouver (District Municipality) has the fourth-highest artistic concentration among large cities (1.8%);
 - Saanich ranks eighth (1.2%);
 - New Westminster is ninth (1.1%);
- 30% of B.C.'s artists reside in Vancouver (7,250), compared with 14% of the province's overall labour force.
- British Columbians spent \$3.6 billion on cultural goods and services in 2005 or 3.2% of total consumer spending in the province. The \$3.6 billion in consumer spending on culture is more than four times larger than the \$780 million spent on culture in British Columbia by all levels of government in 2003-04. On a per capita basis, British Columbians' cultural spending is the second highest of all provinces at \$886 per resident.
- In 2005, the three most popular cultural and heritage activities in British Columbia were: reading newspapers (89% of the population 15 or older); listening to music on CD's, cassette tapes, DVD audio discs, records, etc. (84%); and reading a magazine (81%).
- In 2005, 38% of British Columbians 15 or older (1.34 million residents) attended a concert or performance by professional artists of music, dance, theatre or opera (excluding cultural festivals). This is just under the Canadian rate of 41%.

Examples of Canada Council funding in British Columbia⁵

The Canada Council supports the endeavours of professional artists and arts organizations through its programs. The following selection illustrates the scope of the activities supported by the Canada Council in British Columbia.

Barbara Poggemiller of Victoria was awarded an **\$11,500 Grant to Theatre Artists** to create a play for young audiences inspired by the experience of "gifted" children. **Poggemiller** said: "I am compelled by something deep within my own psyche to journey into the realms of children (in particular) who live and experience the world from a different perspective." From May to October 2008, **Poggemiller** will research autism, A.D.D. and A.D.H.D. through interviews with families, occupational therapists, teachers and children. Based on this, she will create a play that animates the altered reality that many children experience within hyper-acute sensory systems. The play will incorporate physical theatre, music, comedy and visual arts, telling the story of a "gifted" girl and her interaction with the world.

The **Victoria READ Society**, a non-profit literacy organisation, received **\$10,000** through the **Co-operative Projects in Writing and Publishing** program to support the 2007 edition of the **Random Acts of Poetry (RAP)** project. The project had 37 acclaimed poets from across Canada, including three of Canada's Poets Laureate, reading poems to strangers in their cities and adjacent small towns for the week of October 1 to 7. On buses and subways, in cafes, in the chiropractor's office, in police stations, in shelters, on city streets and country lanes, poets read their work and distributed their books. "Poetry," says **Wendy Morton**, founder of **RAP**, "is the shortest distance between two hearts. I have read poems to hundreds of people, many of whom hadn't heard a poem in thirty years, and watched their eyes fill up with tears. Some burst into laughter or a laid a hand on my shoulder, hugged me or took my hand."

In 2007-08, an **Assistance to Visual Artists - Project Grant** of **\$20,000** was awarded to Victoria sculptor **Mowry Baden**, to produce work for the National Gallery of Canada's *Caught in the Act: The Viewer as Performer* exhibition. The exhibition, running from October 2008 to February 2009, will showcase Canadian works that engage and even rely on spectators. For almost 40 years, **Baden** has been producing participatory installations that borrow from psychology, architecture and performance. His project involves producing sculptures using large concave mirrors of various sizes that stand just away from the wall and challenge the viewer's estimation of his or her position in space. **Baden** is a professor emeritus the University of Victoria and is a recipient of the 2006 Governor General's Award in Visual and Media Arts.

Through the **Inter-Arts Program: Travel Grants to Professional Artists**, **Tegan Forbes** of Vancouver received **\$1,500** to attend the Pilotprojekt Gropiusstadt Residency in Germany in June 2007. The residency asks artists to respond to the landscape and daily life of Gropiusstadt, a satellite town of Berlin built in the 1960s and 70s, with temporary interventions within public spaces. During her residency, Forbes examined Gropiusstadt's most prominent feature, its 10 to 25 storied building-development. Reflecting on the blind consumer culture of the tourist souvenir, Forbes produced souvenir t-shirts promoting Gropiusstadt's lackluster public housing complexes and photographed herself wearing them in Berlin's tourist hot spots. The work was exhibited at Montreal's HTMLles 8 Festival in October 2007.

A **Music Festivals Programming Project Grant** of **\$8,000** was awarded to Cumberland's **Comox Valley Folk Society**, presenters of the Vancouver Island Musicfest, for a special project entitled **Ancient Voices – Modern Times**. The purpose of the project was to bring together musicians from different cultures and musical disciplines to celebrate the human voice through a 90-minute collaborative performance at the July 2007 festival. Performers included Suba Sankaran of the Toronto world music group **Autoricshaw**, members of California acapella group **Slammin' All Body Band**, Ontario vocal harmony trio **The Marigolds**, Inuk throat singer **Tanya Tagaq** and beat boxer **Shamik Bilgi**.

Ho Tam of Victoria received **\$2,000** through the **Travel Grants to Media Artists** program to present his film **Books of James** at the Hong Kong Lesbian and Gay Film Festival on December 1, 2007. **Books of James** constructs an experimental, personal and political biography of New York City artist and AIDS activist James Wentzy, based on his writing, drawing, and videotapes. **Tam** is an Asian-Canadian artist who works in painting, video, photography, print and public art. He has produced over 15 experimental videos on the themes of identity and history. **Books of James** is **Tam's** first full-length documentary and was chosen as the closing film of the festival. He said: "The screenings in Hong Kong have re-affirmed my commitment in dealing with subject matters of the margins."

A **Dance Touring Grant** of **\$5,883** was awarded to **Co. ERASGA** to present its production, **Field: Land is the belly of Man** in Toronto, Winnipeg, Quebec City and Montreal in May 2007. **Co. ERASGA** is a Vancouver-based contemporary dance company that aims to produce works on issues of identity, ethnicity in a global world, and the nature of self in relation to art. **Field** is choreographed and performed by company founder and director **Alvin Erasga Tolentino**. In the show, he stages the relationship between man and the land, exploring how globalization affects the plight of the traditional Asian rice farmer. The tour was organized to coincide with various 2007 Asian Heritage Month of May celebrations and was aimed at the pan-Asian community and the general public.

Through the **Audience and Market Development Travel Grants: Canada** program, Vancouver's **PuSH International Performing Arts Festival Society** received **\$9,530** to assist with the activities of the **2008 PuSH Assembly**. The PuSH International Performing Arts Festival is a two and a half week-long annual multi-disciplinary platform for contemporary theatre, dance music and various hybrid forms of performance. **The PuSH Assembly** is an industry initiative organized in conjunction with the festival. The initiative seeks to use the festival setting to link Canadian performing artists to foreign buyers with a speed-dating forum, pitch sessions, workshops, keynotes and information sessions. This year's Assembly ran from January 30 to February 3, 2008.

A **\$1,500 Travel Grant to Professional Musicians** was awarded to first-time applicant **Jeffrey Mettlewsky** of **Delta** to attend the 2007 Centre de Création Musicale Iannis Xenakis (CCMIX) Summer Intensive Course in Electronic Music in Paris, France from July 2 to 27. **Mettlewsky** graduated from Simon Fraser University in 2007 with a Bachelor of Fine Arts in Music and currently works as a composer of acoustic and electroacoustic music for various projects. While at the CCMIX course, **Mettlewsky** studied various cutting edge computer softwares designed for electronic music composition, undertook a short compositional exercise and received feedback on his work from course tutors.

In 2007-08, Vancouver's **Théâtre La Seizième** was awarded **\$1,570** through the **Grants for the Translation of Canadian Theatre Works** program for the translation of Darren O'Donnell's play, **pppeeeaaaccccee**, from English to French. **Pppeeeaaaccccee** is set in a fictitious world after a revolution. It attempts to tackle the issue of how to build lasting peace as a society through an imaginative and humorous meditation on the contradictions of human existence. The play was translated by **Lisa L'Heureux**, a young Vancouver theatre artist who had worked with the theatre company in previous productions.

In 2007-08, **Linda McGowan** of New Westminster received **\$6,000** through the **Grants to Professional Writers - Creative Writing** program to produce a book-length, non-fiction manuscript entitled **There is a Way**. **McGowan** has had Multiple Sclerosis since 1983. Since then, she has traveled in 64 countries, on every continent, in a wheelchair. In the manuscript, she will recount her experiences using fact, humour and anecdotes to show that despite obstacles, through optimism and open-mindedness, "there is a way." Readers will follow **McGowan** trekking in Nepal, air ballooning in Australia, walking/wheeling the Great Wall of China, animal watching in Kenya and swimming in the Mediterranean.

Vancouver-based architecture firm, **Hotson Bakker Boniface Haden** was awarded a **2008 Governor General's Medal in Architecture** for its work on the **Nk'Mip Desert Cultural Centre**. The centre is located on desert land belonging to the Osoyoos Indian band, south of the Okanagan Valley. The design is a dramatic and sustainable response to the cultural and natural context of the site. It includes indoor and outdoor exhibits honouring the cultural history of the Osoyoos Indian Band and other features such as the largest rammed earth wall in North America, a habitable green roof, careful water-use management and in-slab radiant cooling and heating.

In 2007-08, **\$20,000** was awarded to southern Haida dance group, **Hltaaxuulang Guud Ad K'aaju**, of the Queen Charlotte Islands through the **Aboriginal Peoples Collaborative Exchange: National** program for the **Haida Song and Dance: North meets South** project. The project involved working collaboratively with northern Haida dance group **Gaaw Xaadee** and other Vancouver Haida singers and dancers to produce a collection of the songs, dances and protocols of Haida Gwaii communities. Knowledge was shared and preserved among participants through presentations and workshops. **Hltaaxuulang Guud Ad K'aaju** commented: "we aimed to demonstrate that there is much more to Haida song and dance than simply singing or wearing regalia, and this project helped to introduce many people to the deep and complex systems developed by our ancestors."

In January 2007, **Barbara Bourget**, the artistic director of Vancouver's **Kokoro Dance**, traveled to Launas, Lithuania, to choreograph a contemporary dance work entitled **Tabula Rasa** for AURA Dance Theatre with an **\$11,500** grant through the **International Co-Production Program for Dance**. **Tabula Rasa** is an ode to Bourget's sister, Linda McCrae, who passed away after spending her last 33 years in a wheelchair. In March 2007, AURA Dance Theatre premiered the piece in Lithuania, then at the Vancouver International Dance Festival and at the Roundhouse Community Centre. In October 2007, **Kokoro Dance** traveled to Lithuania to perform at the 17th International Festival of Modern Dance in Kaunas and Vilnius.

4.0 Overall arts and culture funding in British Columbia from all three levels of government⁶

- Arts and culture funding to British Columbia from all three levels of government stood at \$777.3 million in 2003-04 (the latest year of overall data from Statistics Canada).
- Municipal funding made up the largest share at 40% (\$309.5 million) with another 34% (\$264.7 million) coming from provincial sources. Federal funding (\$203.1 million) made up the smallest share of total government expenditures to British Columbia at 26% of total government expenditures on culture.
- Federal government cultural funding to British Columbia totalling \$203.1 million is primarily concentrated (83%) in three areas – heritage resources (historic parks/sites and nature/provincial parks), broadcasting and film and video. The remaining 17% of funding (\$35 million) is allocated to areas including performing arts (\$14.7 million), literary arts (\$8.1 million), multidisciplinary arts (\$6.8 million) and visual arts and crafts (\$3.4 million). In the comparable year, (2003-04), Canada Council funding accounted for 9% of all federal cultural spending in British Columbia.
- Between 1999-00 and 2003-04, federal cultural spending in British Columbia increased from \$144 million to \$203.1 million (an increase of 41%). During the same period, Canada Council funding in British Columbia increased from \$14.5 million to \$18.5 million.
- The largest part of provincial government funding (87%) is concentrated in three areas – libraries, heritage resources and multidisciplinary. However, funding is also allocated to arts education (\$11.0 million), broadcasting (\$7.8 million) and film and video (\$7.0 million).

5.0 Detailed tables of Canada Council funding to British Columbia

Canada Council for the Arts funding to British Columbia

- Since 1999-00, Canada Council funding to British Columbia significantly increased, rising from \$14.5 million in 1999-00 to \$22.6 million in 2007-08, an increase of 56.16%.
- Grants to British Columbia as a percentage of total Canada Council funding increased slightly from 14.03% in 1999-00 to 14.77% in 2007-08.
- Started in 2007-08, Arts Partners in Creative Development (APCD) is a new three-year investment program designed to support the creation and development of original work that will represent the artistic excellence and diverse cultures of British Columbia. APCD is a strategic partnership of the Province of B.C., City of Vancouver, Canada Council for the Arts, Vancouver Foundation, Vancouver Organizing Committee for the 2010 Olympic and Paralympic Winter Games and 2010 Legacies Now. The Canada Council for the Arts is contributing \$500,000 per year to APCD.

Grant applications from British Columbia

- Since 1999-00, the total number of grant applications from British Columbia artists and arts organizations has decreased substantially from 2,643 applications in 1999-00 to 2,365 applications in 2007-08. British Columbia's share of grant applications decreased from 17.69% in 1999-00 to 16.01% in 2007-08. Its share of grant applications (16.01%) in 2007-08 is above its share of population (13.28%) but lower than its share of artists (18.40%) – see Table 7.

British Columbia – Various comparisons with other provinces⁷

- British Columbia's share of grant funding is slightly higher than its share of population but lower than its share of applications and its share of artists. British Columbia ranks sixth in terms of Canada Council grant funding on a per capita basis per province at \$5.15.
