## 1.0 Overview of Canada Council funding to British Columbia in 2008-09

- In 2008-09, the Canada Council for the Arts provided grants totalling \$21.3 million to artists and arts organizations in British Columbia.
- In addition to grants, \$1.3 million in payments was provided to 2,371 authors through the Public Lending Right program,<sup>1</sup> as well as \$298,000 in special funds in 2008-09. This brings total Canada Council funding to British Columbia to \$22.9 million.
- The Council awarded \$3.4 million (16%) in grants to 308 artists and \$18.0 million (84%) to 357 British Columbia arts organizations in 2008-09.
- Grants were awarded to artists and arts organizations in British Columbia in all disciplines - dance, interdisciplinary and performance art, music, media arts, theatre, visual arts and writing and publishing. In 2008-09, the largest amount of funding went to music (\$4.8 million). Visual arts received the second largest amount of funding (\$3.5 million) followed by theatre (\$3.2 million).
- 2,448 applications from British Columbia artists and arts organizations were submitted to the Council in 2008-09, representing 16.0% of the total number of applications received.
- Funding to artists and arts organizations in Vancouver totalled \$15.1 million, comprising 71.0% of the total funding going to British Columbia. In Victoria, they received \$2.3 million in funds, representing 10.2% of total funding, while Kamloops received \$429,250. A total of 82 additional communities in British Columbia received \$3.5 million, or 16.4% of all funding to the province in 2008-09.
- In 2008-09, British Columbia artists received 14.4% of Canada Council funding to artists, and British Columbia arts organizations received 14.7% of the funding to arts organizations. In total, British Columbia artists and arts organizations received 14.7% of Canada Council funding. In comparison, British Columbia makes up 18.5% of Canadian artists,<sup>2</sup> and represents 13.2% of the total population of Canada.<sup>3</sup>
- 116 British Columbia artists and arts professionals served as peer assessors in 2008-09, making up 14.4% of all peer assessors.

## 2.0 Statistical highlights about the arts in British Columbia<sup>4</sup>

- In 2006, there were 25,900 artists in British Columbia. Among the 10 provinces, it had the largest percentage of its labour force in arts occupations (1.08%).
- Between 1991 and 2006, the number of artists in British Columbia increased by 58%. The rate of growth in the number of artists was higher between 1991 and 2001 (47%) than between 2001 and 2006 (8%).
- In 2006, the median earnings of artists in British Columbia were \$11,700, less than half the typical earnings of all B.C. workers (\$25,700).
- In 2006, of nine arts occupation groups, musicians and singers represent the largest group in British Columbia with 5,900 people reporting earnings, followed by authors and writers (4,300), visual artists (3,800), artisans and craftspersons (3,500) and producers, directors, choreographers and related occupations (3,500).
- British Columbians spent \$3.6 billion on cultural goods and services in 2005 or 3.2% of total consumer spending in the province. The \$3.6 billion in consumer spending on culture is more than four times larger than the \$780 million spent on culture in British Columbia by all levels of government in 2003-04. On a per capita basis, British Columbians' cultural spending is the second highest of all provinces at \$886 per resident.
- In 2005, the three most popular cultural and heritage activities in British Columbia were: reading newspapers (89% of the population 15 or older); listening to music on CD's, cassette tapes, DVD audio discs, records, etc. (84%); and reading a magazine (81%).
- In 2005, 38% of British Columbians 15 or older (1.34 million residents) attended a concert or performance by professional artists of music, dance, theatre or opera (excluding cultural festivals). This is just under the Canadian rate of 41%.

### *Examples of Canada Council funding in British Columbia<sup>5</sup>*

The Canada Council supports the endeavours of professional artists and arts organizations through its programs. The following selection illustrates the scope of the activities supported by the Canada Council in British Columbia.

An **International Touring Assistance in Music** grant of **\$26,000** was awarded to **Jim Byrnes and the Sojourners** to tour through Europe in April and May 2009, as a means to expand their performance profile in the European market. Actor and blues legend **Jim Byrnes** and the Vancouver gospel trio, consisting of Marcus Mosely, Will Sanders and Ron Small, undertook a two-week tour through the Netherlands, with additional stops in Paris and London for workshops and showcase performances. The group's objective was to increase record sales and enhance its ever-growing international fan base. The group hopes the tour will demonstrate to European agents and audiences a high standard of professional performance and an exceptional mastery of musicianship.

In 2008-09, **Peter Morin** of Victoria received **\$35,000** through the **Assistance to Aboriginal Curators for Residencies in Visual Arts** program to participate in a one-year Aboriginal Curatorial residency at the **Western Front Gallery** in Vancouver. This residency is centered on the research and development of an exhibition featuring the work of six First Nations contemporary artists, who are also fluent speakers of their respective indigenous languages. The goal is to document their artistic processes as they intersect with their practice of speaking. Over the course of the program, **Morin** will work with a number of Western Front colleagues in developing and nurturing his professional curatorial practice.

**Lawrence Shapiro** received **\$1,400** through the **Travel Grants to Dance Professionals** program to travel from Vancouver to Glasgow, Scotland, to present at the **Moving On: an Examination of Dance and Disability** conference in March 2009. The conference brought together performers, choreographers, and policy makers to debate a wide range of topics surrounding dance and disability, including its status and profile, performance and audiences, aesthetics and research. A dancer with a disability, **Shapiro** was able to discuss the current situation of integrated dance in Canada, while working alongside the world's leading dance professionals committed to the evolution of integrated dance. For **Shapiro**, the benefits of attending such a groundbreaking conference will prove fruitful for years to come.

The **British Columbia Cowboy Heritage Society** was awarded **\$5,000** through the **Spoken Word and Storytelling Program** to present the **Kamloops Cowboy Festival** in March 2009. The Society's flagship event, the annual Festival celebrates and showcases cowboy art, poetry, storytelling and music from rural Western Canada, and provides emerging and established artists an opportunity to perform in front of live audiences. While in past years the Kamloops Festival appealed to older fans of western heritage music and cowboy poetry, organizers were optimistic that the 2009 programming would attract a younger, more diverse audience without sacrificing the traditional high standards of originality and performance.

Vancouver's **Dawn Brennan** was awarded **\$10,000** as the 2009 winner of the **John Hobday Award in Arts Management** to pursue a **Master of Arts in Leadership** at Royal Roads University. The masters is a two-year distance learning program designed to develop sophisticated leadership and problem solving skills for managing today's multifaceted learning organizations. As the current General Manager of Safety and Health in Arts Production and Entertainment (SHAPE), **Brennan** is one of British Columbia's most seasoned and respected non-profit arts managers, having gained considerable wealth of knowledge by working for various institutions across Canada. By attending the program, **Brennan** hopes to share her new skills and mentorship abilities with her community for many years to come.

Through the **Assistance to Visual Artists: Long-Term Grants** program, Vancouver photography artist **Althea Thauberger** was awarded a two-year grant totalling **\$80,000** to produce several new pieces. Over the next two years, the artist will travel to the Canadian Forces base in Kandahar, Afghanistan, to photograph soldiers, producing a work intended to promote discussion. **Thauberger** will also stage a historically specific debate at the Hart House Debate Club in Toronto with the intention of engaging audiences on issues that have deeply affected Inuit communities in the East Arctic. **Thauberger** is known for her collaborative works involving both professional and non-professional participants, and believes these projects will profoundly challenge her practice and perspective.

The **In-SHUCK-ch Services Society** was awarded **\$4,500** through the **Aboriginal Peoples Music Program** to host the **In-SHUCK-ch Days Festival** in August 2008. The free two-day cultural event featured traditional arts, crafts, ceremonies, and games. During the Festival, community members and the general public celebrated Aboriginal practices and culture through live entertainment, cultural workshops, arts and crafts activities, and an achievement awards ceremony for youth who have demonstrated excellence in community service or academic success. A non-profit organization seeking to revive and revitalize traditional Aboriginal culture in Deroche, B.C., the Society organizes the **In-SHUCK-ch Days Festival** to give Elders an opportunity to teach valued knowledge and practices to Aboriginal youth, ultimately preserving such practices for future generations.

In 2008-09, **AHS Collective** received **\$29,500** through the **Integrated Arts Program for Organizations: Artists and Community Collaboration** to create **Project Crowning**, a gala exhibition and performance event concluding a two-and-a-half year community exchange initiative between eight artists and 80 seniors in Vancouver. With the aim to reintegrate the knowledge, life experiences, and creativity of seniors into intergenerational creations and presentations, the project allowed participating seniors to share their experiences and celebrate the relationships they built with the artists during the initiative. For **AHS**, the project represented an important step towards redefining the place of seniors within our current society.

With a **\$37,900** grant from the **Music Touring Grants** program, **George Zukerman** of Surrey, B.C., toured to 52 remote communities located in the Northwest Territories, Nunavut, and British Columbia. His purpose was to contribute to Canadian musical growth and awareness in schools, particularly in areas of geographic isolation. From March to November 2008, **Zukerman** and his colleagues performed at numerous schools and community centers, and led educational workshops for children that focused on the universal language of music and the expansion of Aboriginal-infused music. Participants of all age groups have described the performances as unique and rewarding.

Vancouver theatre company **Realwheels Theatre Society** was awarded a **\$16,000** grant through the **Theatre Production Project Grants for Established Artists** program to develop, commission, and produce ***The Promethean Myth Project***. Established in 2003, **Realwheels** is committed to the ideals of access and inclusion, and hopes to serve as a catalyst for social change. Its most recent project combines personal experience with recognizable elements from ancient Promethean myths and Mary Shelley's *Frankenstein* to craft a cautionary tale aimed at challenging those in contemporary society who seek to cure disability. The ***Promethean Myth Project*** hopes to capture the spectators' imagination with its strong images and indulge their fascination with new media, while changing pre-conceptions surrounding disability.

Through the **Assistance to Visual Artists: Project Grants** program, Vancouver's **Xiong Gu** was awarded **\$20,000** to create ***Boundless River***, an installation project focusing on parallels between the Yangtze River in China and the Fraser River in Greater Vancouver. **Xiong Gu**, who has considerable national and international exhibition experience, will use this project to address issues around hybrid culture and its relationship to place, migration, boundary, and transformation in the 21<sup>st</sup> century. With photographs, video, drawings and sculptural elements, the final product will be part of the forthcoming exhibit ***Boundary and Translation: New Art across Cultures*** at the UBC Museum of Anthropology, which is set to coincide with the 2010 Winter Olympics. **Xiong Gu** hopes that this project will increase awareness, respect and appreciation for Canada's rich cultural diversity.

A **\$24,000** grant was awarded to **Marion Quednau** of Mission, B.C. through the **Grants to Professional Writers: Creative Writing** program to create ***The Plagiarist***, a novel which considers the notions of originality and ownership in both literature and life. A published author since the 1980s, **Quednau's** most recent work balances a dual plot. The first deals with the idea of 'literary theft,' involving a woman in the 1990s researching the work of the great novelist E.M. Forster. The second deals with notions of 'identity theft' and takes place in the 1960s when a mother and her two children suddenly appear "without apparent identity or memory of such identity, as to who they really are, at the World's Fair in Montreal at the time." Through this novel, **Quednau** hopes to explore how and why Canadians view the margins of privacy and the applicable laws.

Through the **Aboriginal Media Arts Program**, **Jackson 2bears** of Victoria, B.C., received a **\$25,000** grant to create a video performance work entitled ***The Hauntology of an Undead Indian***. This collaborative project between **2bears** and five other Indigenous artists blends live cinema, scratch-video, and vinyl-tracking technology to create a cultural critique through current perspectives. **2bears** was inspired by a collection of his writings that engage the question of Indigenous identity in contemporary society by considering the themes of history, inheritance, cultural resistance and personal introspection. As with his other projects, **2bears** will use modern technology to challenge audiences to re-examine concepts of Indigenous belonging.

Wen Wei Wang, founder of **Wen Wei Dance** of Vancouver, was awarded a **\$30,000** grant through the **International Co-Production Program for Dance** for the creation of a full-length dance piece with Gao Yanjinzi, resident choreographer of the **Beijing Modern Dance Company (BMDC)**. From January to November 2008, the choreographies worked together in residency in Beijing to create a cohesive, culturally-inspiring performance which will be part of the **Cultural Olympiad** in Vancouver in 2010. As part of the creation process, Gao Yanjinzi and Wen Wei Wang also led technique classes for local dancers, and engaged the wider community in movement workshops. For the participating dancers, this project served as an excellent opportunity to gain practical dance experience.

A **\$20,000** grant was awarded to the **Société Francophone de Maillardville** through the **Music Festivals Programming Project Grants** program to present **Festival du Bois**, an annual celebration of British Columbia's rich cultural diversity mixed with traditional Celtic and French Canadian sounds. In March 2009, the not-for-profit organization hosted the 20th edition of the Festival, which focused on musical performances and educational workshops inspired by Indian and Asian culture. Through its dedication to showcase culturally diverse artists and performers in dance, music, and craft, the **Festival du Bois** has grown into one of the most popular francophone festivals in Western Canada. As a result, it now serves a leading role in the preservation of French Canadian language and traditions in a minority setting.

#### 4.0 Overall arts and culture funding in British Columbia from all three levels of government<sup>6</sup>

- Arts and culture funding to British Columbia from all three levels of government stood at \$821.3 million in 2006-07 (the latest year of overall data from Statistics Canada).
- Municipal funding made up the largest share at 46% (\$380.1 million) with another 30% (\$248.1 million) coming from provincial sources. Federal funding (\$193.2 million) made up the smallest share of total government expenditures to British Columbia at 24% of total government expenditures on culture.
- Federal government cultural funding to British Columbia totalling \$193.2 million is primarily concentrated (78%) in three areas – broadcasting, heritage resources (historic parks/sites and nature/provincial parks), and film and video. The remaining 22% of funding (\$42.5 million) is allocated to areas including performing arts (\$16.5 million), literary arts (\$7.9 million), multidisciplinary arts (\$10.6 million) and visual arts and crafts (\$3.6 million). In the comparable year, (2006-07), Canada Council funding accounted for 10% of all federal cultural spending in British Columbia.
- Between 2003-04 and 2006-07, federal cultural spending in British Columbia decreased from \$203.7 million to \$193.2 million (a decrease of 5%). During the same period, Canada Council funding in British Columbia increased from \$18.5 million to \$19.7 million.
- The largest part of provincial government funding (82%) is concentrated in three areas – libraries, heritage resources and multidisciplinary. However, funding is also allocated to arts education (\$13.0 million), broadcasting (\$12.1 million) and film and video (\$7.3 million).

## 5.0 Detailed tables of Canada Council funding to British Columbia

### *Canada Council for the Arts funding to British Columbia*

- Since 1999-00, Canada Council funding to British Columbia significantly increased, rising from \$14.5 million in 1999-00 to \$21.3 million in 2008-09, an increase of 47.63%.
- Grants to British Columbia as a percentage of total Canada Council funding increased slightly from 14.03% in 1999-00 to 14.65% in 2008-09.
- Started in 2007-08, Arts Partners in Creative Development (APCD) is a three-year investment program designed to support the creation and development of original work that will represent the artistic excellence and diverse cultures of British Columbia. APCD is a strategic partnership of the Province of B.C., City of Vancouver, Canada Council for the Arts, Vancouver Foundation, Vancouver Organizing Committee for the 2010 Olympic and Paralympic Winter Games and 2010 Legacies Now. The Canada Council for the Arts is contributing \$500,000 per year to APCD.

**Grant applications from British Columbia**

- Since 1999-00, the total number of grant applications from British Columbia artists and arts organizations has decreased substantially from 2,643 applications in 1999-00 to 2,448 applications in 2008-09. British Columbia's share of grant applications decreased from 17.69% in 1999-00 to 15.99% in 2008-09. Its share of grant applications (15.99%) in 2008-09 is above its share of population (13.15%) but lower than its share of artists (18.49%) – see Table 7.

- British Columbia's share of grant funding is slightly higher than its share of population but lower than its share of applications and its share of artists. British Columbia ranks fifth in terms of Canada Council grant funding on a per capita basis per province at \$4.87.
