These figures include Prizes under parliamentary appropriation and exclude the Public Lending Right Program, the Canadian Commission for UNESCO, the Art Bank as well as Prizes, endowments and fellowships that are not under parliamentary appropriation. The total number of distinct peer assessors by region are not equal to the sum of assessors by region as some assessors moved, and the data show different addresses for different assessment services.
